Reflection By Sr. Michaelene

This second Sunday of Easter gives us so much to think about, it's hard to center on any one thing. Perhaps the response to the Psalm (118) is most fitting in that it covers it all:

"Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good.
His love is everlasting!"

It's not strange – since this is Divine Mercy Sunday – that mercy jumps out of the readings several times. We hear in the psalm: "God's mercy endures forever." And in the second reading (1 Peter): "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who in his great mercy gave us a new birth to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,..."

In our everyday lives, how do we experience this "new birth to a living hope"? St Thérèse of the Child Jesus (the "Little Flower.") found great peace in her awareness of God's mercy. For years, she struggled for perfection. Realizing that this was beyond her power, she was crushed ...for a while. Confident that God would not inspire her with impossible desires, she trusted in him to bring her to the perfection he desired for her in his own way.

We find a similar humility in Thomas in today's Gospel. Confronted with the Risen Jesus, he must have been overjoyed – and perhaps a little embarrassed! Once he acknowledged the presence of Jesus, his Lord and Master, Jesus swept away Thomas' anxieties and confirmed him as blessed. And Jesus blessed all those who believe "though they have not seen." (that's us!) Imagine how Thomas must have felt then and how he must have reveled in the mercy God lavished upon him.

This is the kind of mercy described in the story of the Prodigal Son. Pope Francis tells us the prodigal's father "was waiting for him, he had been staring out at the horizon waiting for his son's return..."

Thomas experienced this mercy in abundance. God waits for each of us with that same eagerness and that same warm embrace.

Divine Mercy Service, Today

In honor of Divine Mercy, we will be having a service at St. John's church beginning at 3pm. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed and we will pray The Chaplet of the Divine Mercy.

Shortly before the outbreak of World War II, a simple, uneducated, young Polish nun received a special call. Jesus tells her, "I am sending you with My mercy to the people of the whole world. I do not want to punish mankind. But I desire to heal it, pressing it to My merciful Heart." Jesus also tells her to record His message of mercy in a diary: "You are the secretary of My Mercy. I have chosen you for that office in this and the next life." Our Lord Jesus said to St. Faustina: "Encourage souls to say the Chaplet which I have given you. Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death. Even if there were a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from my infinite mercy. Through the Chaplet you will obtain everything, if what you ask for is compatible with my will." (From the diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska.)

Reflexión

Recibid el Espíritu Santo. A quienes perdonéis los pecados, les quedan perdonados

Hoy, Domingo II de Pascua, completamos la octava de este tiempo litúrgico, una de las dos octavas —juntamente con la de Navidad— que en la liturgia renovada por el Concilio Vaticano II han quedado. Durante ocho días contemplamos el mismo misterio y tratamos de profundizar en él bajo la luz del Espíritu Santo.

Por designio del Papa San Juan Pablo II, este domingo se llama Domingo de la Divina Misericordia. Se trata de algo que va mucho más allá que una devoción particular. Como ha explicado el Santo Padre en su encíclica *Dives in misericordia*, la Divina Misericordia es la manifestación amorosa de Dios en una historia herida por el pecado. “Misericordia” proviene de dos palabras: “Miseria” y “Cor”. Dios pone nuestra mísera situación debida al pecado en su corazón de Padre, que es fiel a sus designios. Jesucristo, muerto y resucitado, es la suprema manifestación y actuación de la Divina Misericordia. «Tanto amó Dios al mundo que le entregó a su Hijo Unigénito» (Jn 3,16) y lo ha enviado a la muerte para que fuésemos salvados. «Para redimir al esclavo ha sacrificado al Hijo», hemos proclamado en el Pregón pascual de la Vigilia. Y, una vez resucitado, lo ha constituido en fuente de salvación para todos los que creen en Él. Por la fe y la conversión acogemos el tesoro de la Divina Misericordia.

La Santa Madre Iglesia, que quiere que sus hijos vivan de la vida del resucitado, manda que —al menos por Pascua— se comulgue y que se haga en gracia de Dios. La cincuentena pascual es el tiempo oportuno para el cumplimiento pascual. Es un buen momento para confesarse y acoger el poder de perdonar los pecados que el Señor resucitado ha conferido a su Iglesia, ya que Él dijo sólo a los Apóstoles: «Recibid el Espíritu Santo. A quienes perdonéis los pecados, les quedan perdonados» (Jn 20,22-23). Así acudiremos a las fuentes de la Divina Misericordia. Y no dudemos en llevar a nuestros amigos a estas fuentes de vida: a la Eucaristía y a la Penitencia. Jesús resucitado cuenta con nosotros.
