**Reflection
By Father Richard**

The Tuesday before last, a group of us watched a very fine video on the life and thought of G.K. Chesterton (1874-1936), presented by Bishop Robert Barron. Chesterton was raised as a somewhat lukewarm Unitarian. His movement towards Christianity and, eventually, to Catholicism began when he met his future wife, Frances. He said that Frances was the first Christian he met who was happy! It was her deep Christian joy that made Christ and Christian faith and life attractive and credible to him. I've been thinking since then of some of the happy Christians I've known who've helped make Christianity and Jesus attractive to me – and then reflecting on where in my own life I find happiness and joy. Pope Benedict XVI frequently spoke of Christian joy: in fact, for him, joy is THE defining characteristic of a Christian disciple. Here's what he said about it to a group of young people in 2012: "Christianity is sometimes depicted as a way of life that stifles our freedom and goes against our desires for happiness and joy. But this is far from the truth. Christians are men and women who are truly happy because they know that they are not alone. They know that God is always holding them in his hands. It is up to you . . . followers of Christ, to show the world that faith brings happiness and a joy which is true, full and enduring. If the way Christians live at times appears dull and boring, you should be the first to show the joyful and happy side of faith. The Gospel is the "good news" that God loves us and that each of us is important to him. Show the world that this is true! Be enthusiastic witnesses of the new evangelization! Go to those who are suffering and those who are searching, and give them the joy that Jesus wants to bestow. Bring it to your families, your schools and universities, and your workplaces and your friends, wherever you live. You will see how it is contagious. You will receive a hundredfold: the joy of salvation for yourselves, and the joy of seeing God's mercy at work in the hearts of others. And when you go to meet the Lord on that last day, you will hear him say: "Well done, my good and faithful servant... Come, share your master's joy" (Mt 25:21)."

Reflexión

“Yo soy la puerta de las ovejas”

Hoy, en el Evangelio, Jesús usa dos imágenes referidas a sí mismo: Él es el pastor. Y Él es la puerta. Jesús es el buen pastor que conoce a las ovejas. «Las llama una por una» (Jn 10,3). Para Jesús, cada uno de nosotros no es número; tiene con cada uno un contacto personal. El Evangelio no es solamente una doctrina: es la adhesión personal de Jesús con nosotros.

Y no sólo nos conoce personalmente. También personalmente nos ama. “Conocer”, en el Evangelio de san Juan, no significa simplemente un acto del entendimiento, sino un acto de adhesión a la persona conocida. Jesús, pues, nos lleva en su Corazón a cada uno. Nosotros también lo hemos de conocer así. Conocer a Jesús no implica solamente un acto de fe, sino también de caridad, de amor. «Examinaos si conocéis —nos dice san Gregorio Magno, comentando este texto— si le conocéis no por el hecho de creer, sino por el amor». Y el amor se demuestra con las obras.

Jesús es también la puerta. La única puerta. «Si uno entra por mí, estará a salvo» (Jn 10,9). Y poco más allá recalca: «Nadie va al Padre sino por mí» (Jn 14,6). Hoy, un ecumenismo mal entendido hace que algunos se piensen que Jesús es uno de tantos salvadores: Jesús, Buda, Confucio..., Mahoma, ¡qué más da! ¡No! Quien se salve se salvará por Jesucristo, aunque en esta vida no lo sepa. Quien lucha por hacer el bien, lo sepa o no, va por Jesús. Nosotros, por el don de la fe, sí que lo sabemos. Agradecámoslo. Esforcémonos por atravesar esta puerta, que, si bien es estrecha, Él nos la abre de par en par. Y demos testimonio de que toda nuestra esperanza está puesta en Él.
