**Reflection  
By Sister Kathy**

The greatest among us...

At the evaluation of our parish picnic, the committee decided that next year, we need a team to clean up after the geese before the tent is erected. Not a pleasant prospect, but unless the geese decide to gather elsewhere, it is a necessary step. Any volunteers?

I was reminded of a friend of my brother in New Jersey. Barry has two hunting dogs. Not that he hunts, but the dogs like to chase anything that moves. The owners of the local golf course advertised in the local paper for dogs that would chase the geese from the golf course. There was a small stipend, and the dogs would work for 20 minutes two times a day. Barry was interested, believing it was good exercise for the dogs.

Things started off well. The dogs were enthusiastic and eager to begin each day. They chased the geese for 20 minutes and seemed satisfied that they had done a good job. However, after two weeks, things began to change. The dogs were no longer eager to run, appeared to tire easily, and ran back to the truck before the 20 minutes were over. A week later, it was obvious the dogs were uninterested. Their little doggy brains seemed to have grasped the fact that, in spite of their best efforts, the geese were there to stay. They lost their job.

I think of how we often experience the same rhythm in our efforts to be of service. We have good intentions, begin with enthusiasm, and feel some level of satisfaction. But then, we hit a wall. The neighbor we are visiting complains incessantly; the relative we care for tells friends we never stop in; the child we are mentoring tells us she is bored; the efforts we put into preparing cakes and cookies go unacknowledged; the patient we take to the doctor's office becomes more demanding; the efforts we put into committee work are overlooked. And so, we get discouraged and decide we should put our efforts elsewhere.

Today's gospel tells us that the greatest among us must be the servant. It doesn't say we will be refreshed or satisfied. It just says we should continue to be faithful.
